

## **General Assembly Meeting Minutes Teleconferencing**

Friday, February 15, 2013 at 10:00 a.m.

A meeting of the MCDA General Membership was held via teleconferencing on Friday, February 15, 2013. Attending were: Rodney Lynch, Planning Consultant; Tom Martin, HCPC; Tony Levesque, Town of Fort Fairfield; Tim Curtis, Town of Madison; Dan LaPointe, Town of Van Buren, Darryl Sterling, Central Maine Growth Council, Deborah Johnson, Department of Economic and Community Development; Joella R. Theriault, Northern Maine Development Commission and Beverly Gerardi, Senior Program Director, Midcoast Economic Development District. Gail Chase of Kennebec Valley Council of Governments joined the meeting at 10:21 a.m.

- 1. <u>Call to Order:</u> Rodney Lynch, MCDA President, called the meeting to order at 10:07 a.m.
- 2. Review November 15, 2012 Meeting Minutes: Moved by Tony Levesque and seconded by Tom Martin to approve the November 15, 2012 meeting minutes as presented. Approved.
- 3. <u>Treasurer's Report:</u> Rodney Lynch presented the Financial Report for the period ending December 31, 2012. See attached Financial Report. Moved by Darryl Sterling and seconded by Joella Theriault to approve the financial report as presented. Approved.

#### 4. Report of Committees:

- <u>Professional Development</u> –Darryl Sterling will be attending the MMA Affiliate meeting on March 22, 2013. He is working on organizing a May 30, 2013 training session at the Sea Dog Restaurant in Bangor. Proposed training/professional development sessions discussed include-
  - "How To" workshops
  - Proposed Changes to the 2014 CDBG Program Statement
  - Evaluation of Proposed Changes to the 2013 CDBG Program Statement
  - Transportation Alternatives MAP 21 legislation
  - Panel on MDOT, DEP, EDA, RD projects and funding
  - Maine Real Estate Development Association (MREDA) to speak on economic and demographic forecasting throughout the State of Maine
  - Alternative Financing Sources

Darryl Sterling proposed two sessions: 1) Maine Real Estate Development Association (MREDA) and 2) alternative financing to begin at 8:00 a.m. and conclude at 3:30 p.m. on May 30, 2013. Tony Levesque proposed a "How To" workshop on housing inspections by Mike Baran of Maine State Housing Authority. This could be a day-long session in itself and could be held at a separate training session. Moved by Tony Levesque and seconded by Tom Martin to accept Darryl Sterling's proposal as outlined and charge non-MCDA members a fee of \$25 for the training sessions with MCDA members to attend free of charge. Approved. Rodney Lynch outlined the menu for the day with a basic breakfast for \$5.97 and dinner of either deli cuts or Italian pasta for \$13.95; unanimous decision to go with Italian pasta. Pre-registration will be required to assure that the \$1,100 program cost is covered. In conjunction with the training session a MCDA business meeting will be held as well.

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- <u>Membership</u> Steve Dyer (Chair) was not in attendance. Current 2013 attendance list is attached.
- O Communication and Newsletter Joella Theriault (Chair) apologized for not having the October-December issue of the Newsletter ready; however it is 95% complete and will be completed as soon as possible. Darryl Sterling will provide information on the professional development training session slated for May 30 in Bangor as well as other articles for inclusion in the next newsletter. Deborah Johnson suggested an article on Efficiency Maine and PACE.
- <u>Advocacy</u> Dan LaPointe (Chair) reported meeting with the congressional representatives of Sen. Collins' and Rep. Michaud's offices and communicated to them MCDA's position on CDBG. Deborah Johnson will be meeting with Sen. King's office in the near future and will be discussing the CDBG program with his representatives. Dan LaPointe recommended that MCDA revisit issues with the CDBG program after the March 1 deadline of the 'fiscal cliff'. Deborah Johnson suggested we contact our legislative delegation representatives and provide them with success stories of the CDBG program. The Maine delegation is pro-CDBG, but if they have specific success stories to communicate to fellow members, it may be helpful when voting on the CDBG budget.

Tom Martin questioned the infrastructure funding proposed in the President's Budget., Deborah Johnson reported that in past years, additional funding such as the Neighborhood Stabilization Project and the Jobs Act were administered through the CDBG Program, which brought in additional funds. This would give the CDBG program a tremendous amount of funding; however, these funds could be administered through the DEP, USDA Rural Development or the Drinking Water Program.

- 5. CDBG Updates from DECD-OCD staff: Deborah Johnson reported that the submission of Letters of Intent (LOI) via e-mail worked very well. As of this date, there has been in excess of \$6.7 million for the public infrastructure program, 4 LOIs submitted for the Micro-Enterprise Program, 1 LOI for workforce development, 4 LOIs for Downtown Revitalization, and 6 LOIs for Economic Development for an overall total request of \$9,643,994. Other than the Housing Assistance Program with an LOI deadline of March 15, the economic development and workforce development programs are open throughout the program year.
